





Wednesday, June 17, 2026 - The Adventure begins...

Thursday, June 18, 2026 - Europe/Nairobi

After your overnight flight, connect to your onward journey for an evening arrival at Nairobi's **Jomo Kenyatta International Airport**. Here you will be met and assisted through the airport, then transferred to **Hotel Rudi** in Karen. There will be a short briefing while you eat a late, light meal.

Welcome to Kenya - Karibu Kenya!



Friday, June 19, 2026 - Nairobi

After a sumptuous breakfast on the terrace, there will be an opportunity for a quick run to the ATM should you wish to obtain Kenya shillings locally.

Later this morning we embark to **Kiambethu Tea Farm** for lunch and tour. The farm sits at 7200 feet and has been run by 5 generations of the McDonell clan.

Here we learn about tea farming, walk the gorgeous grounds, stroll through the forest, and have a delicious lunch in the beautiful manor house.





Mid afternoon, (time permitting,) we visit the **Nairobi National Museum**. Here we'll view the fascinating exhibit, Cradle of Human Kind gallery.

Our guided tour will serve as an introduction to the history of Kenya, her people, wildlife, and art.

Dinner and overnight at Hotel Rudi.

Saturday, June 20, 2026 - Amboseli


Today, we head south, enjoying a scenic drive to Tawi Conservancy, adjacent to **Amboseli National Park**, and Mt. Kilimanjaro.

We arrive at **Tulia Amboseli Camp** in time for lunch.

Unpack, relax and enjoy the view! This afternoon, step into the wild as we experience local wildlife on a nature walk!

Sunday, June 21, 2026 - Amboseli

We breakfast "under canvas," then game drive through the park en route to **Amboseli Trust for Elephants**. Here, we have a special window into wild elephant existence in the region, and experience a research camp. We'll explore this gem of a National Park on game drives – including an exclusive visit with a researcher from the trust.


The knowledge gained from this team has profoundly altered the way we think about, conserve, and manage elephant populations. Their research has highlighted the ethical implications of dealing with sentient, long-lived, intelligent, and socially complex animals.

For almost five decades Amboseli Trust for Elephants's presence has helped ensure the survival of the elephants as well as the Amboseli ecosystem.



Monday, June 22, 2026 - Amboseli

Early morning up, and out with packed picnic breakfast. We will be on special lookout for the "SuperTusker" males that frequent the area around Tawi Conservancy. Lunch in camp, final afternoon game drive looking for that perfect shot of animals in the foreground, and Mt Kilimanjaro filling the backdrop of the frame!

Tuesday, June 23, 2026 - Amboseli/Nairobi

We bid farewell to Amboseli this morning, and depart to the town of Emali, where we board the comfortable SGR train line, for our return to Nairobi.

Upon arrival, we will do a bit of sightseeing, and shopping before returning to Hotel Rudi for the evening.

Wednesday, June 24, 2026 - Masai Mara

This morning we are driven to **Wilson Airport** for our scenic flight to the **Masai Mara**.


Upon landing, we are met by our driver guide, and game spot our way to our under canvas home for the next 5 days!

Thursday, June 25, 2026 - Masai Mara

Here, we have twice daily, and sometimes, all day game viewing in the **Masai Mara**.





Enkewa is in big cat area, we will be looking for tawny lions, as well as the elusive cheetah, and leopard.

Our expert Masai Guides and sharp eyed spotters will assist in identifying the high concentration of wildlife, including almost 500 species of birds.

Friday, June 26, 2026 - Masai Mara

Today we may set out for a full day in the Masai Mara.



We will visit at least one river overlook seeking basking crocodiles on the shore, and hippos bubbling and grunting in the water.

Picnic lunch, then late afternoon return to camp. Dinner, and "Sundowners."


Saturday, June 27, 2026 - Masai Mara


You may choose the once in a lifetime experience of an optional hot air balloon ride, departing at sunrise!

Today we may pack a lunch and venture to areas of the Mara not frequented by a lot of tourists. An optional afternoon massage, or embracing the serenity of the camp from your deck are all wonderful choices. A last sunset game drive will long linger in your memory.


Monday, June 29, 2026 - Nairobi

Our final breakfast at Enkewa, then we game drive to the airstrip for our morning return to Nairobi. We may have some time for sightseeing or shopping before we are met by our Ololo guide, and driven through **Nairobi National Park**, en route to our final destination, **Ololo Safari Lodge & Farm**.



An afternoon game drive is recommended - Nairobi National Park is the only spot in the country where you can view nearby wildlife with the twinkling lights of the city skyscrapers juxtaposed in the backdrop as twilight descends.



Tuesday, June 30, 2026 - Nairobi


After a made to order breakfast, we set out for **Sheldrick Wildlife Trust**, situated on the edge of Nairobi National Park.



Born from one family's passion for Kenya and its wilderness, the Trust was established over 45 years ago and is the most successful elephant orphan rescue and rehabilitation program in the world.

We learn the history of this inspirational rescue, committed to helping elephants, and so many other creatures in need of assistance.

The balance of the day allows time to pack, perhaps take a farm tour, or walk to **Kitengela Glass** and view the pioneering glassblowing studio where they turn discarded glass into functional works of art.



Tented cottage @ Ololo - \$70 per person per night.

Inclusions/Exclusions

Hotel Rudi - Full Breakfast, and Dinner. Coffee, Tea, filtered water. Soft drinks, bottled water alcoholic beverages are extra, as is laundry.

Tulia Amboseli Safari Camp - All meals, Coffee, Tea, filtered water at meals and in tent - Soft drinks, alcoholic beverages, bottled water, are extra, as is laundry.

Enkewa - All meals, as well as beverages, bottled water, all liquor that is not a "Premium" type. Laundry is included.

Ololo - All meals, beverages, bottled water, all liquor that is not a "Premium" type. Laundry is included.

We have found that at Hotel Rudi, and Tulia Amboseli Camp, out of pocket expenses for bottled water, soft drinks, wine, beer, most mixed drinks, and laundry to be very reasonably priced.

All meals are included on Safari, excepting 1 lunch in Nairobi.





Tipping, items of a personal nature, souvenirs are not included. Tipping standard is a minimum of \$40 per person, per day in Kenya. You are tipping your driver guide, waiter, room attendant, and more. You will be assisted with tipping suggestions at each property.

Comprehensive travel tips are sent upon receipt of deposit.

Deposit of \$1200 per person is required to confirm your spot in safari. Trip cancellation charges are \$800 per person up until 61 days prior to departure. Within 60 days of departure you are under a 100% cancellation penalty. Travel insurance is strongly recommended.
